Admissions Requirements

CONTENT ASSESSMENT

- Applicants must demonstrate acceptable levels of content knowledge prior to entering the program.
 - Applicants may do this in one of the following ways:
 - Bachelor's degree in the subject the candidate wants to teach with a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0
 - Bachelor's degree in the subject the candidate wants to teach, with a GPA of at least 2.50 and five (5) years of professional experience
 - A bachelor's degree and proof of passing the <u>state</u> <u>approved content area exam(s)</u>. If you are unsure what exam you need to take, please contact <u>stevgros@iu.edu</u>.

ADDITIONAL REQUIRED ITEMS

- Personal statement (1-2 pages, single-spaced, 12-point font)
 - Why are you applying? Why are you pursuing a career in teaching?
 - Explain your experiences working with youth.
 - Describe what makes an effective teacher and traits/ experiences you possess that will serve you in the profession.
 - What skills and tools do you need to gain or strengthen in order to become an effective teacher?
- Two letters of recommendation
- Official transcript(s).
 - Transcripts must be sent directly from the university/college at which they were earned to stevgros@iu.edu or to Indiana University South Bend.
 - Transcripts from Indiana University need not be sent.
