

Secondary Transition to Teaching

Admissions Requirements

BASIC SKILLS ASSESSMENT

- All applicants must provide passing scores for the [Praxis Core Academic Skills for Educators Exam](#) unless they are exempt.
 - Applicants are exempt if they satisfy one of the following:
 - ACT with a score of at least 24 based on Math, Reading, Grammar, and Science
 - SAT with a score of at least 1100 based on Critical Reading and Math
 - GRE with a score of at least 1100 based on Verbal and Quantitative prior to 8/1/11 **OR** GRE with a score of at least 301 based on Verbal and Quantitative on or after 8/1/11
 - A Master's Degree from a regionally accredited institution

CONTENT ASSESSMENT

- Applicants must demonstrate acceptable levels of content knowledge prior to entering the program.
 - Applicants may do this in one of the following ways:
 - Bachelor's degree in the subject the candidate wants to teach with a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0
 - Bachelor's degree in the subject the candidate wants to teach, with a GPA of at least 2.50 and five (5) years of professional experience
 - A bachelor's degree and proof of passing the [state approved content area exam\(s\)](#). If you are unsure what exam you need to take, please contact stevgros@iu.edu.

ADDITIONAL REQUIRED ITEMS

- Personal statement
- Two letters of recommendation
- Official transcript(s)
