Admissions Requirements

BASIC SKILLS ASSESSMENT

- All applicants must provide passing scores for the <u>Praxis Core</u> <u>Academic Skills for Educators Exam</u> unless they are exempt.
 - Applicants are exempt if they satisfy one of the following:
 - ACT with a score of at least 24 based on Math, Reading, Grammar, and Science
 - SAT with a score of at least 1100 based on Critical Reading and Math
 - GRE with a score of at least 1100 based on Verbal and Quantitative prior to 8/1/11 OR GRE with a score of at least 301 based on Verbal and Quantitative on or after 8/1/11
 - A Master's Degree from a regionally accredited institution

CONTENT ASSESSMENT

- Applicants must demonstrate acceptable levels of content knowledge prior to entering the program.
 - $_{\circ}~$ Applicants may do this in one of the following ways:
 - Bachelor's degree with a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0
 - Bachelor's degree with a GPA of at least 3.0 in the last
 60 credit hours of the undergraduate degree
 - Bachelor's degree with a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5 and qualifying GRE scores.

ADDITIONAL REQUIRED ITEMS

- Personal statement
- Two letters of recommendation
- Official transcript(s)
